When will you schedule your dress-up session?

How to incorporate color:

- Look for an unexpected color combo.
- Keep tones consistent.
- Pair complementary colors together.
- Wear different shades of the same color.

How to incorporate pattern:

- Pair inverse color patterns.
- Same print in complementary colors.
- Same pattern in different sizes.
- Two different prints in the same color.

Textures that work well together:

- Cotton, polyester, and rayon all look awesome with either leather, metallic, or suede.
- Denim and lace is a haute combo.
- Denim and sequins are the definition of smart casual.
- Wool and leather is a great autumn and winter pairing, as is wool and suede.
- And finally, silk and leather balance sophistication and edginess perfectly.

Here are some fabulous layering combos to try out and experiment with:

- A turtleneck under a sleeveless dress – perfect for a more casual yet quirky style.
- A button down under a chunky knit sweater (with or without sleeves), so long as the lengths are complementary.
- A button down under a cute sleeveless dress.
- A denim jacket under a leather jacket [as long this doesn't create too much bulk in your upper body]
- A dress over fitted jeans or pants.
- A denim jacket under a long, wool coat.
